Competition - Enrollment

- Inscriptions must be submitted only on line through web site WKU (World Karate United) www.wkuitalia.com - following the instructions inside the web for inscriptions of Shotokan Karate;
- The “**INTERNATIONAL CUP**” Competition is open to all Federations and Associations registered to Promotion Organizations who identify with this style and this Regulation;
- For more informations regarding the regulation and categories for the Shotokan Karate sector, you can contact Maestro Vincenzo Russo - tel. +39338-969.21.35 he is authorized in the name and on behalf of WKU, FESAM, FEIKAR and SHOTOREIGIKAN for traditional karate;
- It's very important to communicate the Last Name, First Name and phone number of the person (Master or Instructor or Chief gym) which inserts the names of the athletes in the categories;
- In respect of this discipline and of the athletes please are not permitted screams and shouts of encouragement before, during and after the race;
- During Kumite competitions, a Head Coach can sit in a designated area near the Officials's desk.
- During kata competition with point system, Shushin Referee or Fukushin can not be replaced from their assigned Tatami, until the end of the pool.
- The Shushin Referee or Fukushin can be replaced during the Pools of Kumite;
- Referees must wear the Federal uniform of their organization, and be provided of personal whistle;
- Anyone who tramples the competition area, will have to do it bare foot;
(no one is allowed to walk on competition area with shoes on.)

Four finalist athletes will be awarded (1st-gold medal/2nd – silver/ 3rd bronze/ 4th –bronze).

- Inscriptions on the place will not be accepted.
- Categories are subject to change based on the number of competitors;
- Categories with less than four athletes will be grouped together in the category best suited to them;
- Every competitor can participate in two competitions: Interstyle and Traditional Karate (the competitions and Regulations are different)

Pool less than 16 athletes will do only one elimination with point system, only one tokui kata from the designated list of kata. There will be only four finalists.

In case of draw,

From white to orange belt can repeat the same kata

From green to black belt must change kata, it is possible to alternate 2 kata.

JIU KUMITE - REGULATION

JIU KUMITE

For Jiu kumite, the athlete must have already turned 18, the organization reserves the right to control requesting the identity document.

Jiu Kumite (free Kumite) will be of 2 minutes actual time . The timing of the match starts when the Shushin Referee gives the signal to start, and it does not stop at every yame, but it stops only if the Referee gives the signal to *stop*.

2 Wazaari or in the case of 1 Ippon

ENCHO SEN = extension of the match of 1 minute in case of draw.

Enchosen is an extension of the match, and all wazari and penalties issued still apply.

If at the end of "ENCHO SEN" there is still a draw, a new match (Sai Shai) will be held:

"**SAI SHAI**". Every score and penalty from previous match will be canceled and a new 2 min. match will start, if it still ends up in a draw, a winner must be determined by (HANTEI) Referee and judges' decisions.

If the match after the extension "ENCHO SEN" is still a draw (Hikiwake), it will pass to "**SAI SHAI**" re-encounter with **2 minutes** of actual time, only at this stage scores and penalties of the previous match will be canceled and a new match will start.

At the end of these last minutes it is necessary to determine a winner, the decision is taken by all judges.

OUTPUT FROM THE TATAMI = JOGAI

First JOGAI = NOTHING (1th time)
Second JOGAI = NOTHING (2nd time)
Third JOGAI = HANSOKU victory to the opponent

Penalties for HANSOKU

HANSOKU = Nothing (1st view)
HANSOKU = Chui (2nd opinion)
HANSOKU = Shikkaku victory to the opponent

In case of two flags assigned to one of the contenders: the referee (Shushin) is not required to assign the Wazaari if he does not accept the validity of the action (for angles and / or insecurity of Judges Fukushima)

In case of three flags assigned to one of the contenders: the Referee (Shushin) by majority, is obliged to assign the point, even in case of Ippon.

Protections mandatory for Jiu Kumite: from 18 years onwards

- Mouthguards - Gloves knuckle – Groin guards
- Chest protector for women
- Belt red and white staff

- Are not allowed other guards and / or objects that might injure the opponent, such as: rings, necklaces, long nails, bandages with metal staples etc
